Blessed Nicolas Barre was not just a French Minim monk of the mid-17<sup>th</sup> century who provided human and religious education for the young people of his time but he has a tremendous influence through the ages.

In Singapore, the eleven Convent of the Holy Infant Jesus Schools (CHIJ Schools), founded at different times by the Infant Jesus Sisters, deeply rooted in the charism and spirit imparted through the life and writings of Fr Barre, imbibe the same mission, values and motto but express their unique identity in different architectural designs and in the creative expressions of the school population.




